



Northumberland Scouts - Tracker User Guide

Your Supervisor will turn on the Tracker and put it into Tracking Mode. It will stay on for the duration of the Expedition. You shouldn't need to touch the Tracker at all unless sending messages.

Carry the Tracker with the buttons pointing up in the top pocket of your rucksack, if possible use the clip to secure it to stop it getting lost.

Discuss with your Supervisor, in advance, when they want you to use the different Message functions

Messages are only sent one way, from the Tracker to your Supervisor (or in the case of the SOS Button, the Emergency Services). If you need help and are able to phone your Supervisor or your Home Contact then that will always be preferable to using the Tracker Message function.
